One of the most popular suggestions for parental communication has been Class Dojo so I'm writing to you all today to inform you that we will be utilising Dojo moving forwards to replace Twitter. We would like to invite you all to join us on ClassDojo so that we can share all of the wonderful things that are happening at Rosehill. As I'm sure you remember from the infants, Dojo will allow you to share in your child's successes at school through photos and dojo points. The teachers will also be able to send quick reminders about upcoming events and other information to the class pages so I'm sure you will find this really useful.

When you click on the [link below](#) there is the option to 'sign up'. Once clicking on this, it will ask you for your email address, name and to create a password. Remember to read and agree to the terms! Once you've completed this, scroll down the list to find the name of your child's class teacher. Click on the teacher's name and then start typing your child's name into the box which will make it available for you to click on. Finally, click on 'request to connect' which will send a request to your child's class teacher.
