Things you can do to help

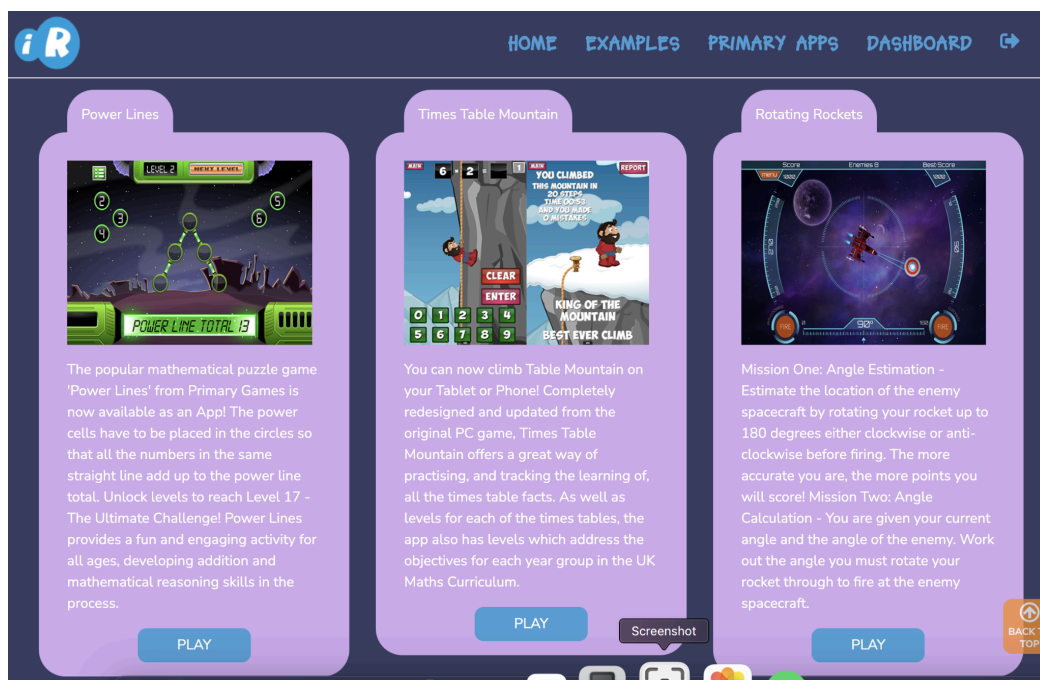
